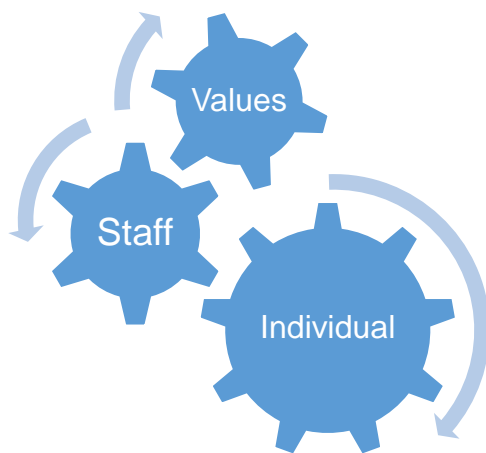

What We Found Out



The PROACT-SCIPr-UK[®] framework is effective in developing staff's knowledge and confidence.



Dissemination of the PROACT-SCIPr-UK[®] philosophy within organisations is an important factor, however this can be inconsistently undertaken.



Dissemination will depend upon the Director/s commitment to the philosophy; the organisation's culture; policies and procedures; the staff members they employ; and the training delivery and approaches.



What Should Happen Next?



Development of quality assurance processes to support reviewing the implementation of the PROACT-SCIPr-UK® framework within organisations.
